## Security advice for Mobile Banking

Mobile e-banking involves risks. There is the risk of losing your mobile phone, or that malicious code ends up on your device to steal your access data or manipulate your transactions.

We offer the best possible security for e-banking and help ensure that the bank's computer system and electronic data transmission are protected. But it is still of the utmost importance that you, as an e-banking client, protect your own device as well.

Protect yourself by doing the following:

- Comply with all security measures, just as you do with e-banking from home.
- Protect your mobile device with a passcode.
- Do not store your access data on your mobile device.
- Always use the most recent version of your operating system and perform regular updates.
- Use updated antivirus software and a personal firewall.
- Download apps only from reliable sources.
- Be careful when opening MMSs. MMSs can be used to spread malicious code. Immediately delete MMSs from unknown senders.
- Turn off the auto-answer calls setting. This setting can be abused to establish connections without being noticed.
- Don't root or jailbreak your phone. (Doing so interferes with the security infrastructure.)
